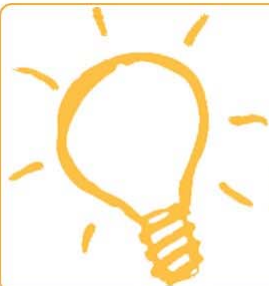
EMCC is at Thomas and Dysart roads in Avondale.

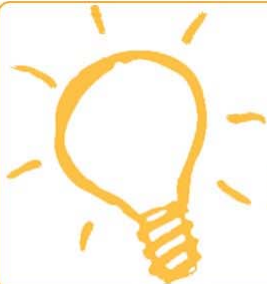
