3 new faculty members at EMCC

Three new faculty members will be teaching <u>classes</u> this fall at Avondale's Estrella Mountain Community College.

• Ernest Chavez, mathematics: He holds a bachelor's degree in <u>secondary education</u> mathematics from Arizona State University, and a master's in math education from Northern <u>Arizona University</u>. In his 10 years of community-college teaching, Chavez taught at Gateway and Chandler-Gilbert community colleges.

• Holly Dison, mathematics: She holds a bachelor's degree in pure mathematics from the University of New Mexico, and a master's in applied mathematics from the University of Washington. Dison has taught <u>math</u> at ASU, Scottsdale Community College and, most recently, at EMCC. She worked with other faculty members to develop new curriculum for intermediate <u>algebra</u>.

• Shannon Manuelito, biology: She holds a bachelor's degree in animal science with a minor in environmental management, and a master's in biology, both from New Mexico <u>State University</u>. She taught several courses in biology and chemistry at EMCC last year and led an electronics recycling drive at the Maricopa Community College District Student Conference.
