Two Estrella Mountain Community College students were recognized for their academic achievement and receipt of at the All-Arizona Academic Team Recognition Ceremony held last week on the Mesa Community College campus. EMCC elementary education major Monika Groomes was honored as a second team member; and EMCC Lauren Hansen was recognized as a third team member.

The All-Arizona Academic Team recognizes scholarly achievements of students from junior, technical and community colleges.

Each student is awarded a full, two-year waiver provided by the Arizona Board of Regents, good at any Arizona public university. Additionally, each college president awards a \$1,000 scholarship to members of the first team, a \$750 to members of the second team, and a \$500 scholarship to members of the third team. The students are also eligible for the Phi Theta Kappa All-USA recognition program co-sponsored by *USA Today*.
