

Recycle e-waste Saturday at EMCC in Avondale

Drop off your electronics to be recycled from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday at Estrella Mountain Community College, 3000 N. Dysart Road, Avondale.

Other than a \$5 disposal charge for televisions, the event is free.

Residents may drop off desktop computers, laptops, monitors, printers, network cards, routers, hard drives, floppy and CD-ROM drives, copiers, fax machines, telephones, cellphones, test equipment, wire and cable items, power-supply units, circuit boards, video game equipment, calculators, typewriters, stereo equipment, credit-card machines, VCRs, small appliances and televisions.

The recycling collection is sponsored by EcoAvenues, E-Waste Harvesters, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality and Avondale.

When the last collection was held in January at the college campus, it boasted the highest attendance since ADEQ began the program in 2009, with 750 vehicles bringing 58,524 pounds of e-waste to be recycled.
