His main jobs included helping injured pilots out of airplanes, putting out fires and repairing F-14 aircraft.

"One of the most rewarding things was being able to do something or learn something different every single day," Amos said.

During his 12 years of service, he was a part of Operation Iraqi Freedom, was stationed in San Diego, Washington state, Japan and had six months of training with a number of different countries through a "world cruise," he said.

Amos served as a recruiter in Houston and then in Arizona before he decided to go back to school to complete his higher education.

"You might as well live doing something you enjoy doing, and talking to people is something I enjoy doing," he said about choosing psychology as his major.

Amos is currently taking classes at Glendale Community College, but is enrolled to take classes at Estrella Mountain Community College in Avondale in the spring. He also works as a student worker for EMCC's Veterans Center and is the Veterans Club student government representative.

This year, the Veterans Club is launching its first Veterans Fitness
