### **Priority Registration Now Open at Estrella Mountain Community College**

Current EMCC students can register at EMCC for summer and fall

AVONDALE, ARIZONA, March 7 – Priority registration for Estrella Mountain Community College (EMCC) summer and fall classes has begun. Priority registration at EMCC is available to current EMCC students and runs through March 17. Open registration for new students begins on March 18.

Registration can be done online at <https://my.maricopa.edu/>, in person in Komatke Hall B at 3000 N. Dysart Road, Avondale, or via phone by calling 623-935-8888. Registration remains open until classes start. The summer semester begins May 28 and ends Aug. 1. The fall semester runs Aug. 17 through Dec. 13.

Normal hours of operation for the Registration Office are 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Friday. During spring break, the office is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. March 11-13 and closed March 14-15. Summer hours are 7:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.
